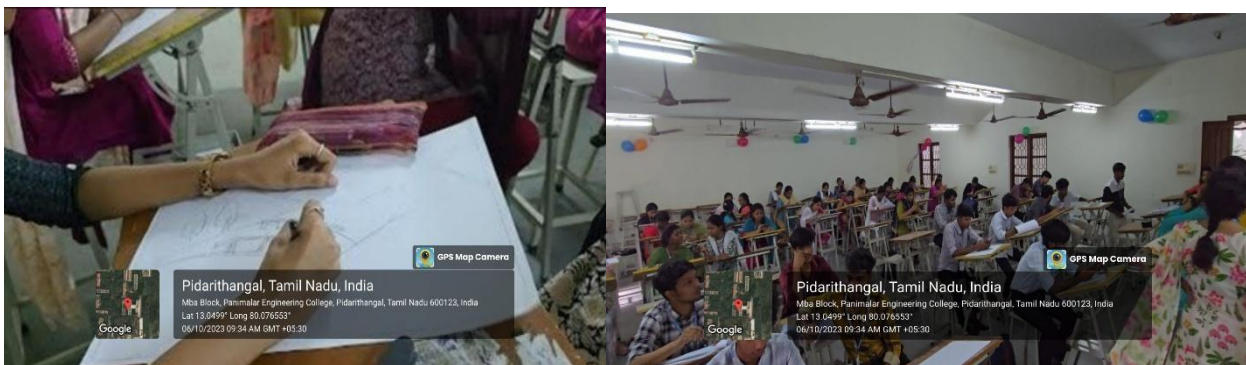
### Description

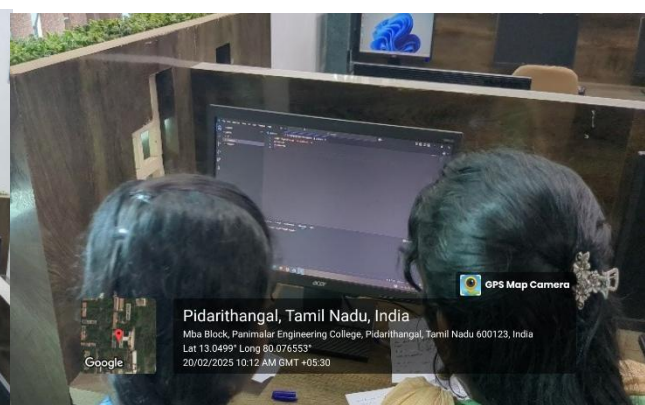
### Description
