Objective

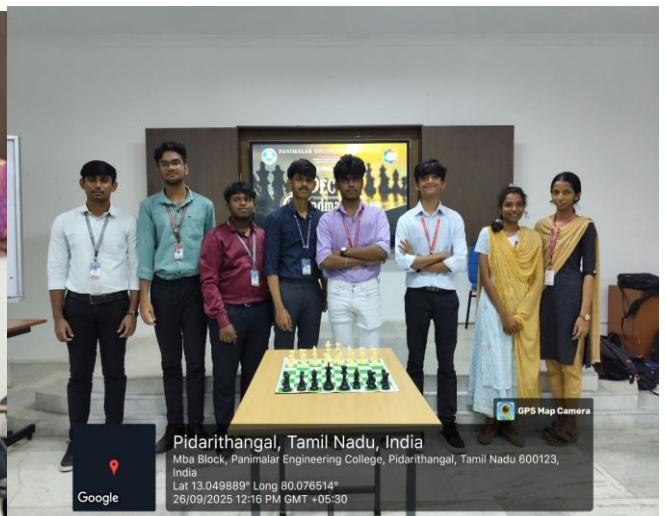

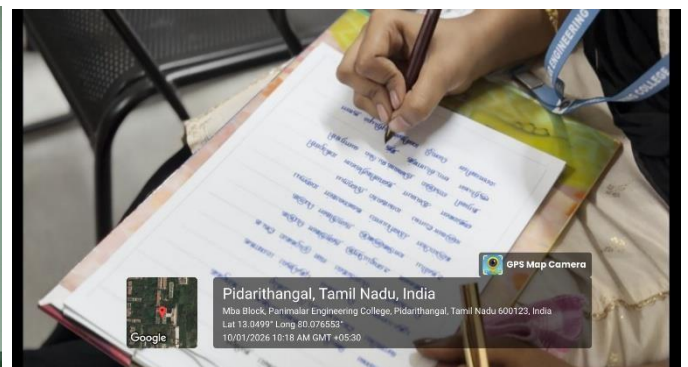
Description

To promote traditional games and cultural engagement among students. The event aimed to encourage teamwork, coordination, and active participation while preserving cultural values.

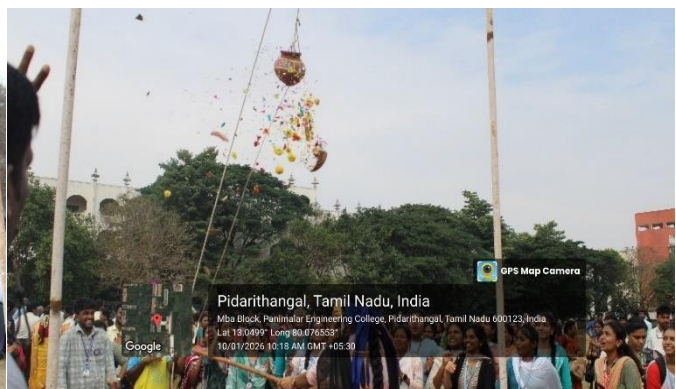
Description
