AGENDA-NO•1/25:

Dr. N. Manoharan (Ombudsman, Member) informed that the issues given by the students regarding ERP issues like Login issues, Registration failures, Provision for issue of Hall ticket and Bonafide certificates.

RESOLUTION-NO•1/25:

Dr. N. Manoharan (Ombudsman, Member) informed the committee about various issues raised by students concerning the ERP system. The key concerns included login difficulties, registration failures, lack of provision for issuance of hall tickets, and delays in obtaining bonafide certificates.

After deliberation, the following resolutions were proposed:

1. Login Issues:

The ERP Department shall conduct a thorough review of the authentication system and resolve recurring login problems. A dedicated helpdesk will be established to assist students facing access issues.

2. Registration Failures:

The ERP system will be audited to identify and fix technical glitches causing registration failures. A retry mechanism with proper error notifications will be implemented.

3. Hall Ticket Provision:

Necessary updates will be made to enable seamless generation and download of hall tickets through the ERP portal within the stipulated timeline.

4. Bonafide Certificate Issuance:

An online request and approval workflow will be integrated into the ERP system to facilitate timely issuance of bonafide certificates.

5. Monitoring and Timeline:

The IT Department is instructed to resolve the above issues on priority and submit a status report within two weeks. Continuous monitoring will be carried out to ensure system reliability.

The committee emphasized the need for prompt action to ensure minimal disruption to students' academic activities.


















Dr. N. Manoharan (Ombudsman, Member) extended a warm welcome to the committee and initiated the proceedings. The committee deliberated on the following agenda items:

AGENDA NO•1/23:

Dr. N. Manoharan (Ombudsman, Member) informed that several students raised concerns regarding the loud playing of songs inside the college buses during travel. Students reported that the high volume created discomfort, disturbance, and inconvenience, especially for those wishing to rest or complete academic tasks during travel. The Redressal Committee conducted a meeting with the transport in-charge, route supervisors, and drivers to discuss the matter in detail.

The respective in-charges accepted the lapse, stated that the drivers were unaware of the disturbance caused, and assured that music playing inside buses would be strictly prohibited henceforth.

All the members welcomed the decision and the immediate corrective measure taken. After this, the following resolution was passed.

RESOLUTION NO•1/23:

Resolved, that the Compliance-cum-Redressal Committee unanimously approved the decision to stop the playing of songs in all college buses and confirmed that the instruction has been implemented immediately.

AGENDA NO•2/23:

Dr. N. Manoharan (Ombudsman, Member) informed that Telugu-speaking hostel students requested the inclusion of Telugu movies during weekend screenings. Students expressed that currently screened movies were predominantly in Tamil and English, which did not meet the entertainment preferences of Telugu students residing in the hostel. The Committee arranged a meeting with the hostel in-charge and wardens to address the issue.

The respective in-charges accepted the lapse in ensuring inclusive

entertainment options and assured that Telugu movies would also be added to the weekend movie schedule.

All members welcomed this inclusive decision. After this, the following resolution was passed.

RESOLUTION NO•2/23:

Resolved, that the Committee unanimously approved the inclusion of Telugu movies in hostel screenings and confirmed immediate implementation.

During peak hours, long waiting lines were observed, causing inconvenience, especially for first-year students not permitted to use mobile phones. The respective in-charges accepted the lapse in assessing student requirements and assured that additional landlines would be installed to reduce waiting time.

Dr. N. Manoharan (Ombudsman, Member) informed that students travelling by the Redhills route bus complained about rash and unsafe driving by the assigned driver. Students reported sudden acceleration,
