- This allowed for honest, anonymous suggestions and appreciation messages.

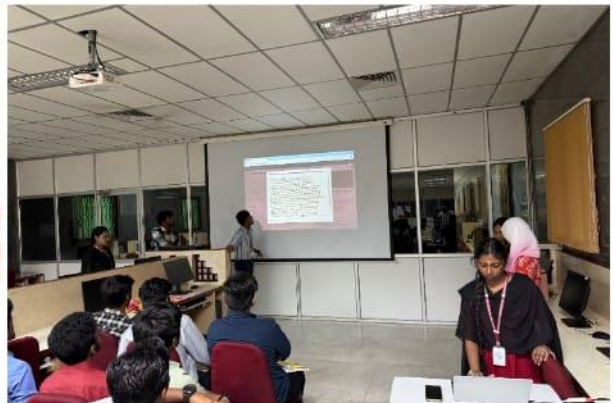
Conclusion:
