## Minutes of the Meeting

- During the review meeting, presentations were made by all research scholars outlining their research objectives, adopted methodology, and progress achieved since the previous review conducted in June 2024. Details pertaining to coursework completion, confirmation status, publications, and current thesis progress were also presented and duly recorded.
- A comprehensive evaluation of each scholar's progress was carried out by the Review Committee, with specific emphasis on the quality of research publications, particularly those indexed in Scopus, SCI, and other recognized indexing databases. The completion status of mandatory academic milestones, including coursework, confirmation, synopsis submission, and thesis work, was verified and documented. The readiness of scholars for progression to subsequent stages, including synopsis submission and thesis submission, was also examined.
- It was observed that a steady increase in research output has been achieved, with several scholars publishing in Scopus-indexed journals and reputed conferences. A number of scholars have progressed to advanced stages of research, including synopsis preparation, thesis submission, and viva voce readiness. Compliance with publication requirements as prescribed by Anna University was verified in many cases.
- It was further observed that a considerable number of manuscripts are currently under review or revision, indicating ongoing research activity. However, in certain cases, improvement is required in the quality of journals selected for publication, particularly with respect to indexing and impact factor. A few scholars were identified with slow or limited progress, including delays in publication initiation. Additionally, certain cases were noted under special categories such as break of study, newly registered scholars, or resigned candidates.
- The Review Committee recommended that all scholars shall focus on publishing in high-impact journals indexed in SCI, Scopus, or Annexure-I, and maintain consistent progress during each six-month review cycle. Scholars were advised to ensure timely completion of all prescribed milestones in accordance with Anna University regulations. Supervisors were advised to closely monitor the progress of scholars, particularly those identified with slow progress, and to ensure adherence to quality standards in publications and timely submission of theses.
- Overall, the progress of research scholars was found to be satisfactory and indicative of continuous improvement compared to the previous review cycle. An increased number of scholars were observed to be nearing completion of their research work. Necessary corrective measures and action plans have been identified for scholars with delayed progress, with emphasis on improving research quality and output.
- The review meeting was conducted successfully, enabling effective monitoring of 149 research scholars. The outcomes demonstrate measurable improvement in research productivity and progression towards completion, while ensuring compliance with NBA accreditation requirements and Anna University norms.
